Georgetown Recreation Center KIDS' CLUB POLICIES

- 1. Kids' Club is for children ages 1 7. Age limits are strictly enforced.
- **2.** Payment must be made at the Recreation Center customer service desk before dropping your child off. Kids' Club Staff cannot accept payments.
- **3.** Each child must have an up-to-date Client Profile in the parent's overall Xplor account that includes an ID photo, health/medical information, and a signed City of Georgetown liability waiver.
- 4. Parent must check children in and out of the Kids' Club each visit.
 - The person signing in must also sign the child out a child will not be released to a different person.
 - ➤ If not the Parent, the person using the service must be another ADULT within the same family account in XPlor (please see FACILITY RULES.)
 - > Parent must remain inside the facility or on the trail through San Gabriel Park.
 - ✓ If using the trail, please have your phone on and be prepared to come back immediately if staff calls.
 - ➤ Parents are not permitted to stay in the room during Kids' Club service hours, though they are welcome come into the play area for up to 10 minutes at check-in to help acclimate their child.
- **5.** The room ratio is 1 staff member for every 10 children. When there are two staff members, up to 20 children can be supervised.
- **6.** Staff will not change diapers parent/guardian will be asked to do so if it becomes necessary.
 - Please use the changing tables in facility restrooms for diaper changes.
 - There is a child-sized bathroom inside the Kids' Club area for those that are potty-trained.
 - If your child is currently potty-training, please take her/him to the restroom before your visit. Please let staff know so they can help and encourage your child.
- 7. Sick children are not permitted to use the Kids' Club.
 - The staff reserves the right to refuse entry to visibly sick children.
 - ➤ If a child becomes ill during visit, staff will find parent and request immediate pick up in order to prevent others from getting sick, too.
 - > Refunds will not be given for dismissals due to behavior or illness.
- **8.** In case of an accident/injury or severe behavior issues (# 9), parents will be notified immediately. For minor issues, parents will be updated when child is signed out.
- **9.** When a child is crying and inconsolable, or his/her behavior is disruptive or harmful to self/others, and s/he will not respond to distraction/redirection/correction, the parent will be found and asked to sign the child out for the day.
 - > Refunds will not be given for dismissals due to behavior or illness.
 - ➤ The Staff will fill out a behavior report to document each event. Any child having recurring behavior issues will have their Kids' Club privileges revoked until the issues are corrected.
 - Not all behavior is *bad*! Some small children just aren't ready for the Kids' Club environment or separation from the parent yet.
- 10. Kids' Club Staff will not administer medications; please dose your child before or after your visit.
- **11.** Outside of the Kids' Club service hours, members are welcome to use the room when the Georgetown Recreation Center is open.
 - For the safety of your children, they must be directly supervised by an adult at all times.
 - Please do not try to use the play yard; you will be locked outside.
 - Please put toys away when finished and turn off lights.
