

NO-SEW SOCK BUNNY

Instructions:

1. Fill an old sock with rice up to the beginning of the heel. The sock needs to be able to stand up vertically on its own once it is stuffed.
2. Form a pear shape with more rice at the bottom than the top. Pinch 2/3 of the way up the stuffed area to push the rice up into the heel and form a separate head and body parts. The ankle of the sock above the head will be used to form the bunny ears.
3. Tie the sock off immediately above the stuffing using twine, string or yarn. This forms the ears. Ensure you tie it off tightly to keep the stuffing in the sock.
4. Use another piece of twine, string or yarn to tie off the neck of the rabbit to form the body and head.
5. With the heel, which will become the face, facing toward you, cut down the center of the ankle of the sock to form the ears. Make them long and floppy!
6. Using the marker, give your sock bunny eyes and a mouth.
7. Add a ribbon around your bunny's neck, and tie in a bow.

Supplies

- Sock
- Rice
- Scissors
- Twine, string or yarn
- Ribbon
